# Community Vaccine Clinics





Getting vaccinated is the best way to reduce your risk from seasonal Flu and COVID-19 and their potentially serious complications.

Everyone 6 months and older should get a flu shot and an updated COVID-19 booster, especially people at higher risk of developing serious complications.

If you have questions or concerns, talk to a member of your health care team.

Manet will be hosting Community Vaccine Clinics at several different sites this fall.

### Please bring your insurance card.

The COVID-19 vaccine is covered by most insurance plans at no cost to the individual. The CDC's Bridge Access Program provides no-cost COVID-19 vaccines to adults without health insurance and to adults with insurance that does not cover all COVID-19 vaccine costs.
